

Purchase Disclaimer

The undersigned/purchaser has ordered a turbo/supercharger kit from Active Autowerke that includes special performance software. This software is designed to raise the top speed governor originally installed in the automobile.

The Active Autowerke turbo/supercharger kit with the performance software may exceed the design limitations for the automobile and its subsystems. Specifically some mechanical modifications may need to be made to the automobile included but not limited to: Z rated tires, high performance suspension, brakes and other components.

The Active Autowerke turbo/supercharger kit is intended to be used under controlled conditions ((for example, a race track or competition event) with proper safety equipment (for example, competition seat belts, air bags, helmets, roll bars and roll cages) and with proper competition driver's training (for example, high speed competition driving). The customer acknowledges the above mentioned safety requirements, and the equipment on the car for such requirements or driving school is at the sole responsibility to the customer.

The installation of the Active Autowerke turbo/supercharger and performance software may void the manufacturer's warranty. Active Autowerke shall not be responsible should the automobile manufacturer void its warranty by reason of the installation of the Active Autowerke turbo/supercharger or software or by any other modifications occasioned because of the installation of the software.

The undersigned agrees to provide Active Autowerke with a signed copy of the Consumer Notice and acknowledgement for each turbo/supercharger kit and performance software sold with the top speed governor raised.

The undersigned releases and forever discharges Active Autowerke and all other persons and associations connected therewith from any and all claims of whatever type or description arising out of, or relating to, the turbo/supercharger kit or performance software. The undersigned further waives ad disclaims the provisions of Civil Code Section 1542 which provides:

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known to him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor"
